Dept (<https://www.deptagency.com/>) is a pioneering technology and marketing services company that creates end-to-end digital experiences for brands such as Google, KFC, Philips, Audi, Twitch, Patagonia, eBay and more.

- As a FrontEnd Developer, I contributed in the effort to refactor a monolithic-type codebase which served frontend pages with a Ruby on Rails integrated solution to dispatch HTML/CSS pages combined along with React, to a more manageable (and separated) Frontend which just used React/NextJS.

We also worked on the creation of components made with React and Scrivito (<https://www.scrivito.com/>) which allowed to create complex components in which props/states could be managed by non-technical people directly which avoided the process of going through the Development team to get “simple” changes done. With React/Scrivito components alone, it was possible to create a full-fledged web page by someone without a background in software development.

- Our main technologies FrontEnd wise were HTML, CSS, JavaScript, ESNext, TypeScript, React, React Hooks, NPM, NextJS, React Testing Library, Jest, Material UI, SWR and Scrivito.

Ágora (<https://agora.red/>) is a local startup focused on building tools for local wellness-focused vendors like yoga instructors, fitness coaches and nutritionists.

- As a FrontEnd Developer, I helped with multiple features on both our public facing application and on our private back office which only the vendors have access to. I've made multiple features on my own and also help the more Junior developers in the team with their own tasks.
- Our main technologies FrontEnd wise are HTML, CSS, JavaScript, ESNext, TypeScript, React, React Hooks and NPM.

BlockFi (<https://blockfi.com/>) is a cryptocurrency exchange and wallet that serves individuals and businesses worldwide. It offers an interest-earning account, portfolio-backed loans, crypto trading capabilities among other features.

- As a FrontEnd Developer, I mainly collaborated on the MobileApplication team and on the Auth team. I also worked on trading, dashboard and QA automation teams. It was a great experience as I was able to see it evolve from a small startup to a more established Unicorn-type of company, and I got to work on many different projects and teams with a lot of great people.
- The main technologies I worked with FrontEnd wise were HTML, CSS, JavaScript, ESNext, TypeScript, React, React Hooks, React Native, Android Development, and Webpack.
